

## **EDICT**

## ANNOUNCING THE OPENING OF THE CAUSE FOR GETRUDE A. BARBER

## LET ALL KNOW THAT:

Whereas the Association for the Cause of Gertrude A. Barber, being a lawfully erected public juridic person, presented a libellus (petition) seeking to open a cause for the possible canonization of Gertrude A. Barber, a lay member of the faithful who lived her entire life in Erie County, Pennsylvania, in the Diocese of Erie;

Whereas the libellus contains all of its required elements (cf. Sanctorum Mater Title V, Article 37);

Whereas I have both evaluated and established the existence of an authentic and widespread reputation of holiness and of intercessory power regarding Gertrude A. Barber (cf. Sanctorum Mater Title V, Article 40) §1;

THEREFORE, I have accepted the libellus of the Association for the Cause of Gertrude A. Barber and I have opened the cause for her possible canonization, focusing on her life, heroic virtues, and reputation of holiness and of intercessory prayer (cf. Sanctorum Mater Title V, Article 40).
